Nisha had her first start in Melbourne at the Friday night Moonee Valley meeting on the December 14 under new trainer Tom Dabernig. She began ok and was able to slot in with cover a little worse than midfield, she was off the bit a long way from home and although she was able to beat a couple home she ran below expectations. Jockey Danny Brereton said he thought she would be better placed in provincial class. The stable is now getting her checked by the vet, as she was cooling down she had several shallow coughs which may indicate that she had a slight throat infection or that she may have bleed (internally) slightly during the run. The vet results will be available next week, however the handicapper has now dropped her rating to 72, which means she can be better placed in provincial company provided she is ok.

TOM DABERNIG PROFILE

Many of you would not know a lot about Nisha's trainer Tom Dabernig, so outlined below is a profile on Tom & his training career. Congratulations to Tom and his wife Cassie who have just recently become proud parents of baby Hugo.

Tom Dabernig's background is steeped in racing tradition gained from his grandfather, the legendary CS Hayes, founder of the fabulous Lindsay Park training facility and father of David and the late Peter Hayes. Tom's mother Jan is CS Hayes daughter and his father Arthur has only recently retired as the Lindsay Park studmaster.

Spending his early years at Lindsay Park, Tom learned all that he could from CS Hayes, eventually working full time at the property where he specialised in breaking in young stock and schooling the jumpers over hurdles. He has also had experience working overseas in England and Ireland at world class training facilities. While assured of a long term future at Lindsay Park, the same bug struck Tom as affected both his uncles, David and Peter Hayes, encouraging him to seek to prove himself by going out on his own.

Even CS Hayes famously made his move outside his comfort zone to establish Lindsay Park at a time when the accepted wisdom was to train at a racetrack.

With the support of friends and associates, Tom has obtained not only a horse training business, but is in partnership with Warren Sutton. The business involves breaking in and pre-training and race horse agistment and is based in Euroa in North East Victoria. The business is known as Creighton's Creek Bloodstock which is an eleven hundred acre property owned by David Hayes. The facilities includes stabling for 65 horses, a fourteen hundred metre all weather private training track, a horse swimming facility, irrigated grass paddocks which the race horses can be turned out to graze on during the day and stabled during the night. This obviously provides a wonderful country atmosphere which the horses tend to thrive in.

Tom is also a fully licensed trainer in Adelaide and has a small stable facility at Murray Bridge, South Australia where he has successfully competed in both provincial South Australia and metropolitan South Australia. One aspect of training that Tom learned well at Lindsay Park is to surround himself with reliable staff. Tom is very lucky to have a skilled team of track riders and ground staff. It is wonderful to have the benefit of Warren Sutton and his breaking in team for difficult horses that require extra attention. Tom and Warren have their own vet, Doctor John Hurley who is the resident vet for Adam Sangster at Swettenham Stud and a full time farrier and a full time racing manager who takes care of all administration duties.

Tom is thirty one years of age and started training in December of 2004 therefore, has been training for three years. Tom has always tried to limit his stable numbers to around twenty in work and feels he can offer a more personalised service to not only the horses but also the clients. During this time Tom has trained forty winners, ninety one place getters and six city winners. In March 2007 Tom married Cassi Maddern and they have recently been blessed with the birth of their first child, Hugo Peter Dabernig. The Dabernig Racing colours of pale blue with black sash and cap look likely to become familiar to racegoers over the next few years as Tom's solid grounding as a trainer converts into racetrack success.

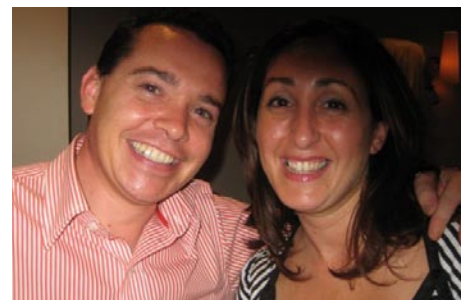

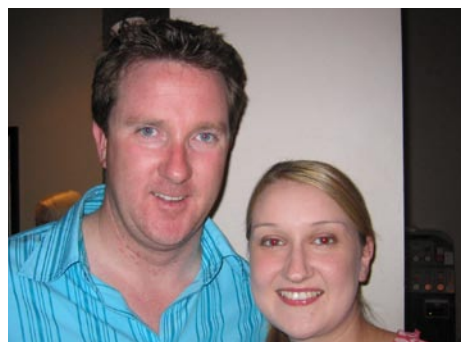
