Nisha has been retired after her last start at Moonee Valley in December, where after a veterinary examination it revealed she had a substantial internal bleed. She will now go back to Queensland where she will go to stud in the latter part of the year. Considering all, it was the best decision to retire her safe and sound. Nisha had 14 starts for 2 wins 4 seconds and 2 thirds and her prize money total was \$33,870 she earned prize money in 64% of her career starts. Thankyou all for your support and participation, and hope the Nisha girls will continue their association with Ggees in the future.

Rebecca Halse got her drivers licence the day after her 18th birthday.



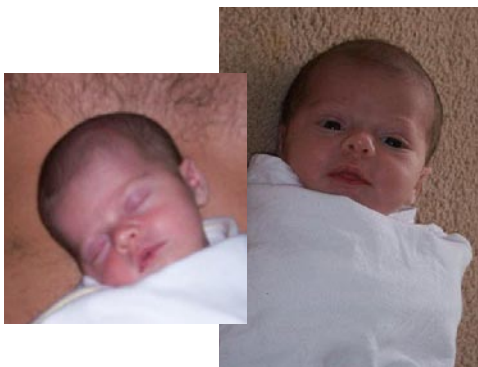


GGEES LADIES NEWS
