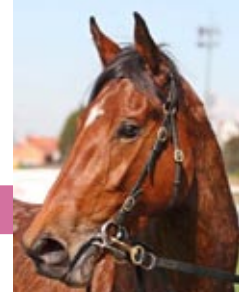
Hannah Lewis

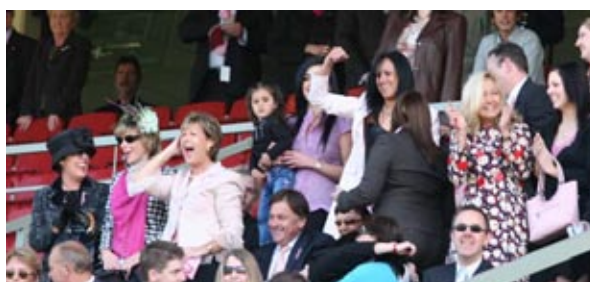


Alison Hurbert-Burns
