Permaiscuous (*Danzero x Permai filly*)

Permaiscuous had her second start this preparation at Moonee Valley on 16 September in the Group 3 Champagne Stakes, 1200m with Brad Rawiller on board, where she finished 3rd in a field of 10. It was a mighty run considering she threw her head around, over raced and still finished 3rd against some very smart fillies





Permaiscuous then headed to Sandown Hillside to a 3YO Handicap race, over 1400m a step up in distance, with several gear changes and minus her signature pink ribbons. She jumped beautifully led the entire race, and won by 4.3 lengths. David Hayes suggested to the media that after that run she may have just invited herself into one of the very good fillies races this spring!!!



Permaiscuous is now set to run in the Group 1, Vinery Stud Thousand Guineas over 1600m on Wednesday 18 October at Caulfield on Ladies Day.

Legs recently won the Group 1 \$1 million Kelt Capital Stakes in New Zealand and in March earlier this year won the Group 1 New Zealand Oaks (2400m) at Trentham The sire of Legs is also the sire of our Ggees filly Red Stiletto. Pins also sired a treble at a recent VRC meeting at Werribee

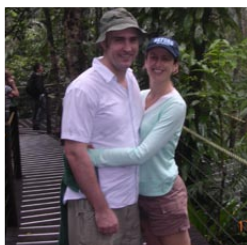
MARRIAGE & ENGAGEMENT
