MELBOURNE FESTIVAL OF RACING

The Melbourne Festival of Racing runs from 3 February and concludes with Super Saturday on 10 March. The festival of racing not only includes some great racing, but also includes some special events in and around Melbourne including the National Jockey Celebration Day on Saturday 3 March. The William Inglis and Sons Premier Yearling Sales at Oaklands junction will be held on 4 – 6 March. Ggees will be speaking at the Inglis/TROA seminar about horse ownership on Sunday 4 March at Oaklands. MVRC had a night meeting that focused on owners on Friday 23 March, and we had co owner of Permaisuous and Red Stiletos, Ang Pippos speaking at the ownership dinner along with Kevin Sheedy, Billy Slater and Simon O'Donnell.

The Herald Sun will had an Ownership liftout where Michael Manley covered a story about Ggees. Inside Racing will also be doing an editorial about Red Stiletos and Ggees. During the festival of racing Ggees will have Permaisuous running along with Red Stiletos in Melbourne, whilst Nisha will run in South Australia.

HORSE NEWS

NISHA (Semipalatinsk x Brave Bride)

Nisha held on for a very brave win in a photo finish on Saturday 17 February at Cheltenham in the SABIS 3YO 2MW Hcp over 1800m with Paul Gatt on board. David Hayes decided to put blinkers on Nisha as she needed to improve her concentration and this move paid off. It was Nisha's fifth start, where she has now recorded two wins, two seconds and a third for \$25,400 prize money. Not once out of the placings, and each time earning a cheque.

This filly began very well and went forward at the start to give herself the run of the race. She travelled beautifully throughout in the blinkers and this piece

of gear really suited her. She hit a flat spot when they quickened and was under pressure, looking a place chance, however then once balanced in the straight she really hit the line strongly to win in photo. It was an excellent performance by this filly. She unfortunately suffered heat stress after this race and had to be treated accordingly at the races. We will continue to monitor her closely and treat her at home. She is expected to fully recover, without any problems, however she is not set to run for another six weeks so will have plenty of time to get over it before we look to get her back to the races.

Her next start is set to be the 1800m Auraria Stakes (G3) worth \$100,000 on 31 March for 3yo Fillies at Morphettville. Provided she has recovered from her heat exhaustion and races well the long term goal is the Australasian Oaks (G1) over 2000m on 21 April worth \$250,000.

ZSA ZSA GABEEL (Zabeel x Golden Winds)

The name Zsa Zsa Gabeel has been approved by the registrar of racehorses with the syndicate that races Zsa Zsa to be called the Ggees Pink Ribbon Two Syndicate.

Zsa Zsa arrived safely from Lindsay Park Euroa to Lindsay Park Angaston (in South Australia) on 3 February where she has settled in well to the pre training stable. She was set to do her third set of even time work (that is working along at 15 seconds to the furlong or 200 metres) on Saturday 24 February. She will move to the racing stable at the end of February where she will commence 14 to the furlong work. Her first gallop is set for the first week of March.

RED STILETTOS (Pins x Red Sophia)

Red Stiletto won her debut at Geelong on 1 February, by 2 ½ lengths.

The Fillies and Mares Maiden Plate was run over 1235m Matt Pumpa was on board and despite looking very lost and very green she went on and hit the line strongly for a most impressive win. Despite it being a work day and a school day about 14 ladies made the drive to Geelong to watch Red Stiletto debut, she was backed in to \$1.60. (A lot of girls buying new shoes after the race it seems !!) Red Stiletto pulled up well after the race however was feeling her shins, therefore the stable have been taking it easy with her, doing light work and plenty of swimming.

Red Stiletto was nominated to run at Kilmore on Kilmore Cup Day however David decided to scratch her because of a number of factors felt would not benefit her long term including the wide barrier around the tight circuit, heat and hard track. After nominating her in 4 races at Moonee Valley over the last week there is a decision to run her at Werribee on 28 February which David feels will suit her better.

A few of you have queried the spelling of Red Stiletto, just to clarify she was registered by the NZ Owners and Stud Book as Red Stiletto – with an S.

PERMAISCUOUS (Permai x Danzero)

Permaiscuous began her campaign this preparation on 3 February at Moonee Valley in The Vanity (G3) over 1200m. However she began nicely settling behind the speed but barely travelled however jockey Damien Oliver reported that it wasn't as bad as it looked. She experienced interference on the home turn which she did not like, and Damien was easy on her and just let her cruise to the line, he did not want to knock her around. Damien said the quick pace does not really suit her anymore, and that she has a very high cruising speed which allows her the ability to lead in races 1400 – 1600 metres, which suit her better. Lindsay park have now reported that Permaiscuous is now getting back to her old self and is actually quite lively again back on the track. She is running in the 3YO Fillies 1600m Angus Armanasco Stakes Group 2 at Caulfield on Saturday 24 February.
